Mar. 1	<b>Required:</b> Preliminary Applications Due at 12 PM - <b>Online</b>	Preliminary application materials due: all items on the relevant grant program(s) application checklist must be included.
Apr. 5 – Apr. 20	<b>Required:</b> Application Site Tours - <b>TBD</b>	Application site tours with reviewers are held for all eligible preliminary applications. LE Feedback will be drafted at this meeting. Potential days are: 4/5, 4/6, 4/7, 4/19, 4/20.
May 2	LE Feedback – <b>Online</b>	LCFRB staff publish LE Feedback for applicants to respond to in their revised application materials.
May 25	First Comment Form from SRFB Review Panel – <b>Online</b>	SRFB Review Panel submits comments for proposals identifying project status.
Jun. 7 - 8	Conference calls with SRFB Review Panel to discuss non-cleared proposals – <b>Phone</b>	One-hour conference calls for proposals identified as Conditioned, Needs More Information, or Projects of Concern. LCFRB staff, TAC representative(s), SRFB Review Panel members, RCO staff and applicants may attend.
Jun. 27	<b>Required:</b> Applications Due at 12 PM - <b>Online</b>	Application materials are submitted in PRISM: all items on the application checklist must be included at this stage. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be reviewed further, and will be withdrawn as incomplete.
Jul. 12	TAC Scores and Rationales Due at 9 AM - <b>Online</b>	TAC members submit scores and deliberations to LCFRB staff for all proposals except for monitoring proposals.
Jul. 21	Final Comment Form from SRFB Review Panel - <b>Online</b>	SRFB Review Panel submits final comments for proposals identifying project status.
Jul. 26	TAC Project Ranking Meeting – <b>TBD</b>	The TAC recommends a ranked project list to the LCFRB.
Jul. 27	TAC Recommended Ranked List Published - <b>Online</b>	Staff publish TAC recommended ranked project list with scoring statistics and deliberations, and LCFRB monitoring ranked list.
Aug. 5	LCFRB Meeting – <b>TBD</b>	The LCFRB approves a ranked project list.
Aug. 8	LCFRB Ranked List published - <b>Online</b>	LCFRB publishes all submitted final applications, TAC deliberations, and LCFRB-approved ranked list.
Aug. 12	LE ranked list submitted – <b>Online</b>	LCFRB submits draft ranked list in PRISM. Applications that are conditioned by SRFB Review Panel must be withdrawn or accept condition by this date.
